Pool Rules and Regulations

1. Every person must wear a clean bathing suit and take a cleansing shower before entering the pool. There are showers located outside on the pool house.
2. Children that are not toilet trained may enter the pool if they are wearing swim diapers. Please take children to the bathroom frequently and change swim diapers often.
3. All children must be accompanied and supervised by an adult at all times, regardless of swimming ability. The lifeguard is responsible for monitoring the pool area, but should not be viewed as a babysitter.
4. Glass bottles are not allowed on deck. Food is also not allowed on the pool deck. Please use the pavilion area for picnicking purposes.
5. The pool has a limited capacity set by the Department of Health. Lifeguards will begin a rotation if capacity is reached.
6. No sick or infected bathers are allowed in the pool.
7. No running.
8. No diving.
9. No spitting.
10. No rough play.
11. No dangerous objects.
12. No smoking.

***The lifeguards are in complete authority of the pool and enforcing of the rules.
They are there for your and your child's safety.***
